However, under the directives of the College and the governing bodies, we all have to do our part to try to stop the spread of this virus.

CDSBC strongly recommends that all elective and non-essential dental services be suspended immediately. All dental offices in BC can only perform Emergency dental services until further notice. We have made the decision to follow these guidelines to provide the quality of dental care and protection that you would expect.

As always, our clinic is up-to-date with infection control materials and information. We are ready to resume dental services with you anytime the College determines that it safe for everyone.
